## A. INTRODUCTION

Data concerning the past, present, and future population of Warren County is presented in this chapter. A study of the demographic characteristics and population distribution is also included.

## B. HISTORICAL GROWTH

According to the Census Bureau, the population of Warren County in 1990 was 26,142. That is more than four times the population of the County's first Census in 1840. The County's population has more than doubled within the past 50 years.

In recent years, Warren County has had one of the highest population growth rates in the Lord Fairfax Planning District. Between 2000 and 2010, Warren County's population grew by 19%.

#### D. RACIAL COMPOSITION

Warren County's population is predominantly white. Minorities made up 9.2 percent of the 2015 population. African Americans made up 5.1 percent of the population in 2015, while whites comprised 90.8 percent. This was similar to other areas within the Lord Fairfax Planning District.

#### E. DENSITY & URBAN/RURAL DISTRIBUTION

The total land area of Warren County is 213.70 square miles. The County's population density in 2010 was 175.8 persons per square mile. That was below the State population density of 202.1 per square mile.

From 2000 to 2010, the Warren County population growth percentage was 19.0%. Twentyfour point 2 percent (24.2%) of the county's residents were under eighteen years of age. In 2015, there were 16,181 housing units in Warren County, 74.8% of which were occupied housing units.

The Town of Front Royal is comprised of 9.5 square miles, of which 9.3 square miles is land and .2 square miles is water. In 2015, the population of the area was approximately 15,070 people. Twenty-five percent of the Front Royal town residents were under 18 years of age; 8.8% were African American; 1.4% were Asian and 4.6% were Hispanic. In 2010, there were 6,184 housing units in Front Royal, 89.9% of which were occupied housing units.
